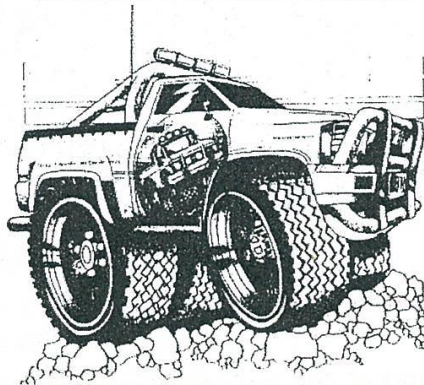

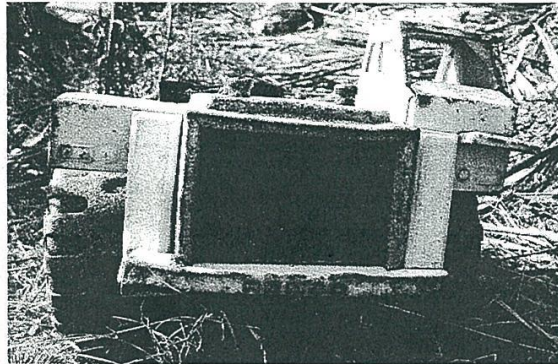

AUGUST 28 2004

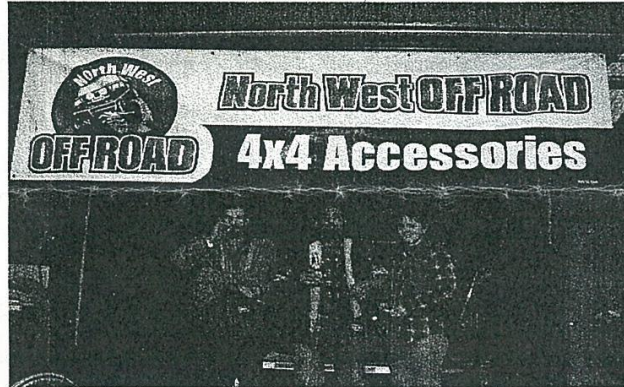

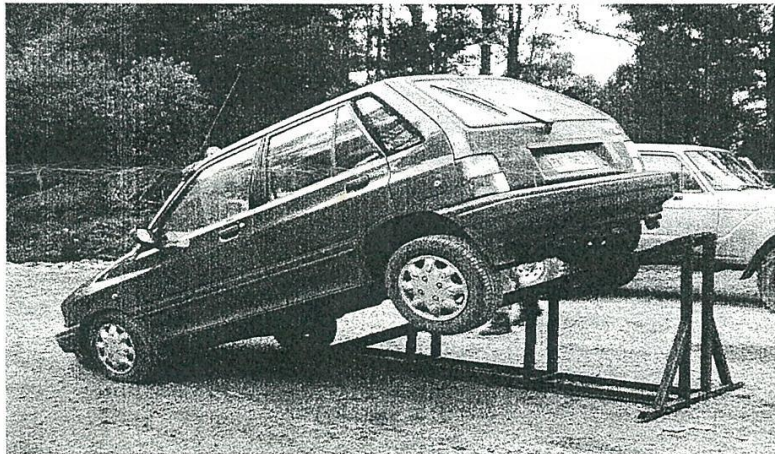
