The lady had been missing since Wednesday and had been seen by a motorcyclist on Friday. A briefing was given to all volunteers and search areas allocated.

Lyndon, Scott and Lyndelle were given an area near her last known position and her car to search. Glenn, Ben and searched the sheepwash area. There was also horse riders, motorcyclists and a helicopter as part of the search.

The terrain in this area is very thick and steep in places, making it hard to see more than a few metres off the track at times.

Mick and Trout arrived after they had been on another club outing that morning in the Smith and Others area, to help out with the search.

Unfortunately Angela was not found on this day

Some members were going to help again on Monday but the search was called off.
